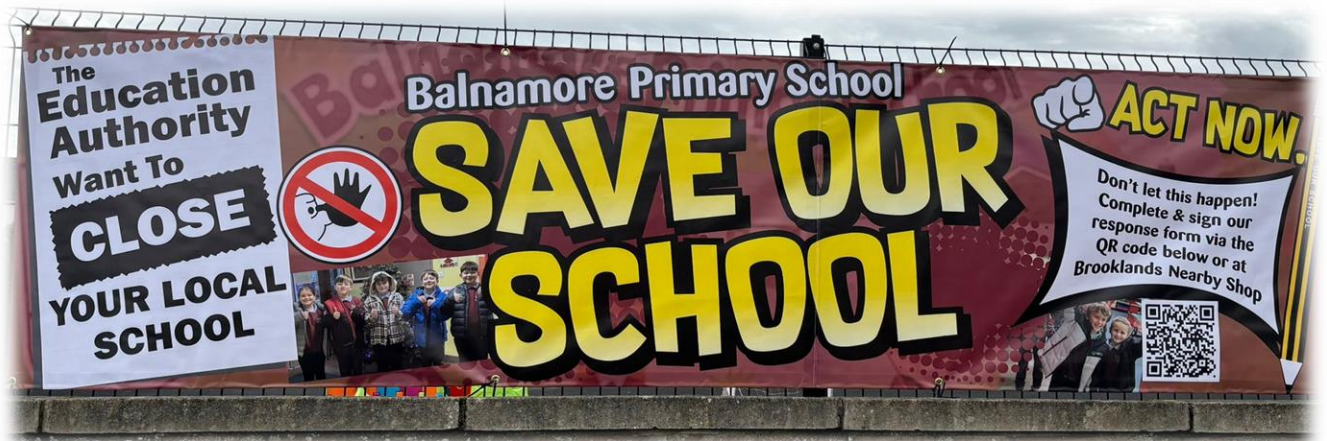

**I extend a really warm invitation to all our parents and indeed the wider community join us in celebrating the opening of our sensory room and come to school on Monday at 10.45am.**



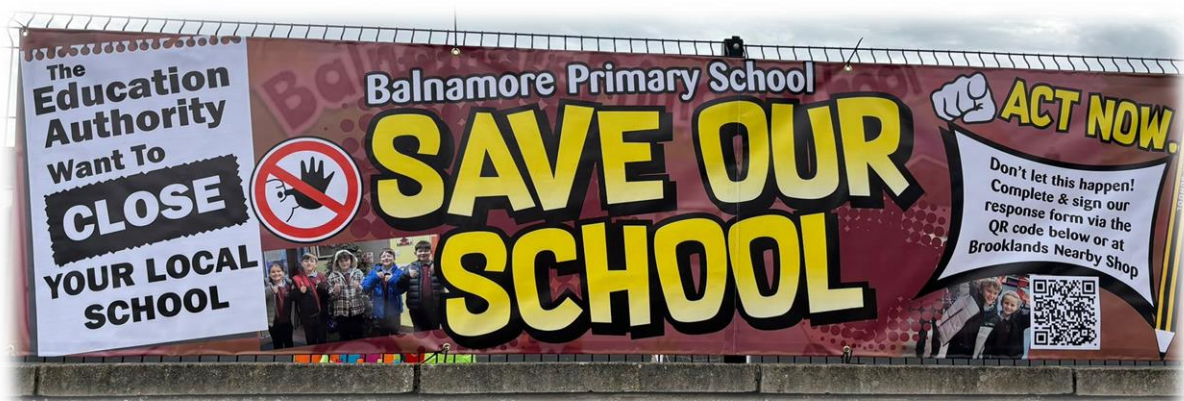

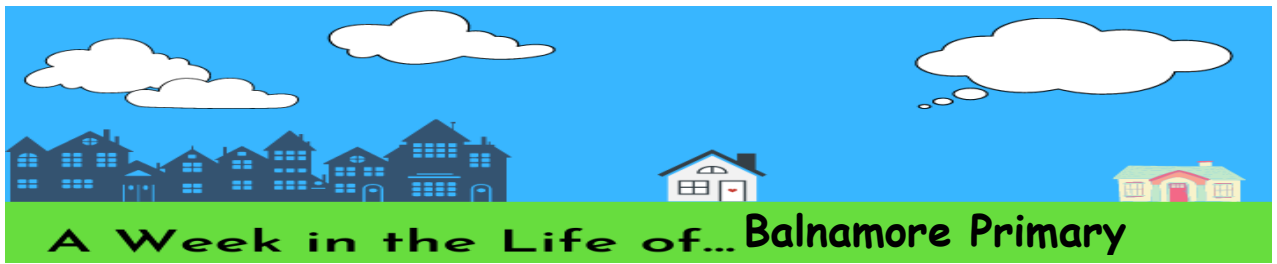
